



Email archive strain

A QUARTER of firms here are struggling to cope with growing email archives.

A survey of 86 companies by Kroll Ontrack suggests one in four IT executives believes the databases will cause a major headache in the next 12 months.

With corporate emails to increase from 156 messages per user, per day, to 233 by 2012, Kroll Ontrack warns that 'back-up everything' policies will strain archives.
